

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: June 20, 2006 – 7:30 P.M.

Place: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Chairman Joe Gonnering, Supervisor John Norman, Town Clerk Barbara Davies, Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Cindy Komro. Excused: Supervisor Ed Doerr, Treasurer Monica Diaz.

Prior to the Meeting, notice was properly posted on the Town Bulletin Boards and mailed to the West Bend Daily News and WBKV AM/FM.

Chairman Joe Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:39 P.M.

Chairman Gonnering asked everyone to join in the Pledge of Allegiance prior to beginning the meeting.

Approval of Minutes – Town Board Meeting of 6/6/06:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to approve the Minutes of the Town Board Meeting of 6/6/06. Carried unanimously.

Comments and Questions from the Audience:

Marilyn John thanked Joe Gonnering for voting in favor of the purchase of development rights at the June County Board Meeting.

Accept/Review Agenda:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to accept the agenda as printed. Carried unanimously.

Gary & Delores Berglin Certified Survey Map:

Frank Mayer stated that the Plan Commission has approved the map as presented, and all required corrections have been made. It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to approve Berglins' Certified Survey Map. Carried unanimously.

Bid Awards – 2006 Crackfilling; 2006 Gravel:

Jim Wollner told the Board that Bartelt Enterprises is the low bidder for the crackfilling @ \$5967.50. It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to award the crackfilling bid to Bartelt Enterprises. Carried unanimously. There were no bids submitted for shoulder gravel work. Wollner will contact Washington County for the shoulder work when the paving has been completed.

Operator's Licenses:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to approve the issuance of operator's licenses to Christian Novales and David Roehrig. Carried unanimously.

Picture ID Cards:

Jim Wollner said that he and Lance had been asked if they worked for the Town when doing a recent culvert inspection. Wollner asked if some type of picture ID card – like those worn by WE Energies employees etc. – would be a good idea. Discussion followed. Cindy Komro offered to take on the ID project.

Health Insurance Deductions, Pay Rates:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to table this matter to the Town Board meeting of 7/6/06. Carried unanimously.

Reports:

Jim Wollner reported that Payne & Dolan has started paving/pulverizing work on Maple Road. Wollner passed the FEMA test for the first NIMS certification. Newburg has inquired about buying road salt this winter. Joe Gonnering will call back and discuss the request.

Frank Mayer reported 14 new home permits with a valuation of \$3,856,328 so far in 2006. 22 new home permits had been issued by this time in 2005. Mayer said he had called the engineer for the Lockhorn project on a culvert problem. The engineer does not feel it is his responsibility to do anything. Discussion followed. The clerk was asked to send a letter to the builder, stating that no occupancy permit will be issued for the home until the Board is sure that the culvert will drain properly. Mayer said that he was thinking of changing his hours on Thursdays: 3:00 – 6:00 P.M. instead of 5:00 – 8:00 PM because Thursday evenings have been very slow. The Board members had no objection to the change.

Cindy Komro said she would post the Town Hall hours on the web site and could upgrade the site with any other information requested. Newsletter articles need to be submitted soon to meet the fall mailing deadline.

Clerk Barb Davies said she will be gone this Friday.

Chairman Joe Gonnering reported receipt of correspondence asking for feedback on the recent ISO visit.

Supervisor John Norman reported that he would be taking the second part of the NIMS test next week – then Jim Wollner will take it.

Payment of Bills:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to approve payment of bills totaling \$29,736.72, and payroll of \$12,990.21. Carried unanimously.
