

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: May 2, 2006 – 7:30 P.M.

Place: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Chairman Joe Gonnering, Supervisor John Norman, Town Clerk Barbara Davies, Treasurer Monica Diaz, Town Attorney Deborah Hoffmann. Excused, out of town: Supervisor Ed Doerr.

Prior to the Meeting, notice was properly posted on the Town Bulletin Boards and mailed to the West Bend Daily News and WBKV AM/FM.

Chairman Joe Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:33 P.M.

Chairman Gonnering asked everyone to join in the Pledge of Allegiance prior to beginning the meeting.

Approval of Minutes – Town Board Meeting of 4/18/06:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to approve the Minutes of the Town Board Meeting of 4/18/06. Carried unanimously.

Comments and Questions from the Audience:

Mike Komro asked about the status of the junk accumulation at a residence on Decorah Road. The resident has received a citation and the case will be heading to court.

Accept/Review Agenda:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to accept the agenda as presented.

Participate in WisDOT Salt Bid – 2006-2007 Winter Season:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to participate in the Wisconsin Dept. of Transportation 2006-2007 salt bid. Carried unanimously. Participation in past years has saved funds spent on salt due to the large number of municipalities participating in the bid.

Approve Memorandum of Understanding – ADA Voting Machine:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to approve the Memorandum with Washington County for the funds outlay for an ADA-approved voting machine. Carried unanimously. Washington County will advance the initial funds for purchase of the machine; when the Town receives the grant funds from the state, it will repay Washington County for the advanced funds.

Approve Issuance of Operator's License – Michael Willavage:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to approve the issuance of an operator's license to Michael Willavage. Carried unanimously.

Conveyance of park:

Attorney Deb Hoffmann said that the closing has been set for 5/8/06 at the Washington County Courthouse.

Adopt Resolution 5-1-2006, National Police Memorial Week:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to approve Resolution 5-1-2006, proclaiming May 14 through May 20, 2006 National Police Memorial Week. Carried unanimously.

Adjourn into Closed Session – Possible Offer of Employment:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to adjourn into closed session for the purpose of discussing a possible offer of employment. Carried unanimously.

Reconvene into Open Session:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to reconvene into open session. Carried unanimously. Gonnering announced that an offer of full-time employment would be made to one of the Town's part-time employees. It would be considered a promotion from part-time to full-time status.
