

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: March 6, 2007 – 7:30 P.M.

Place: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Chairman Joe Gonnering, Supervisor John Norman, Town Clerk Barbara Davies, Treasurer Monica Diaz, Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Cindy Komro. Absent: Supervisor Ed Doerr.

Prior to the Meeting, notice was properly posted on the Town Bulletin Boards and mailed to the West Bend Daily News and WBKV AM/FM.

Chairman Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:40 P.M.

Approval of Minutes – Town Board Meeting of February 20, 2007:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to approve the Minutes of the Town Board Meeting of February 20, 2007, Carried unanimously.

Comments and Questions from the Audience:

Accept/Review Agenda:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to approve the Agenda as printed. Carried unanimously.

Appointments to the Plan Commission:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to reappoint John Baumgartner and Dennis Kay to three-year terms as Plan Commissioners commencing 4/1/07. Carried unanimously.

Trummer Legal Paperwork:

Chairman Gonnering told Trummers that he had discussed the restrictions shown on an older certified survey map with the Town Attorney. The previous restriction on the lots probably related to access to the three lots. Another access to the lots is now available. Discussion followed. Copies of the documents to be signed have been submitted to the Town; Town officials will need the original of each document for signature.

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to approve the Agreement between the Town of Trenton and the Trummers to remove a 1977 deed restriction on three lots. Carried unanimously. Trummers said that the certified survey map would be finalized and ready for signature as soon as the snow permits completion of some final survey details. Approval of the CSM will be placed on the 4/2/07 agenda (Monday evening due to the election).

Appointment to Board of Appeals:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to approve the reappointment of William Buettner to a three-year term on the Board of Appeals commencing 4/1/07. Carried unanimously.

Meeting Dates for Second Joint Meeting:

Chairman Gonnering reported no response from the County group at this time.

Recycling Ordinance, Compliance with State Requirements:

Chairman Gonnering reported that the Town's current ordinance meets state requirements. No action is necessary.

Adoption of DNR Recycling Compliance Assurance Plan:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to approve the Recycling Compliance Assurance Plan drafted by Cindy Komro. Carried unanimously. Komro will fax or email the plan to the DNR.

Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Cindy Komro handed out a copy of the draft newsletter. There is still room for a few short articles. Komro said she would be working on preparation of the ID badges for the Public Works employees.

Treasurer Monica Diaz reported receipt of the state TRIP funds for a 2006 resurfacing project. Diaz said she had mailed out notices to town taxpayers owing delinquent personal property taxes.

Clerk Barb Davies reported that the counter installation/remodeling project has been completed. The ad for the free desks will run in the paper this week.

Chairman Joe Gonnering reported that he had received a notice of an erosion control/stormwater management meeting to be held 3/16/07 at the PAC. Gonnering will ask Frank Mayer if he has interest in attending the meeting.

Supervisor John Norman reported that he had called AT&T for clarification after receipt of a recent letter from AT&T about a new package of services they will offer Town residents for telephone, video, internet, etc. The services will be phased in gradually in the Town as AT&T constructs the necessary transmission boxes in the Town. SEWRPAC and MMSD will be meeting 4/24/07 at the Clarion Hotel in Milwaukee. Norman said he planned to attend the meeting.

Payment of Bills:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Joe Gonnering to approve payment of bills totaling \$38,323.89 and payroll of \$13,986.22. Carried unanimously.
