

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: January 2, 2008 – 7:30 P.M.

Place: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Supervisor Ed Doerr, Supervisor John Norman, Treasurer Monica Diaz, Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Cindy Komro, Town Attorney Deb Hoffmann. Absent: Chairman Joseph Gonnering, Clerk Barbara Davies, Building Inspector/Zoning Administrator Frank Mayer.

Prior to the Meeting, notice was properly posted on the Town Bulletin Boards and mailed to the West Bend Daily News and WBKV AM/FM.

Supervisor Doerr asked the citizens in attendance to join in saying the Pledge of Allegiance.

Supervisor Doerr called the Meeting to order at 7:30 P.M.

Approval of Minutes – Town Board Meeting of December 18, 2007:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Ed Doerr to approve the Minutes of the December 18, 2007 Town Board Meeting. Carried unanimously.

Comments and Questions from the Audience:

Accept/Review Agenda:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Ed Doerr to accept the agenda as printed. Carried unanimously.

Mutual Aid Agreement, West Bend (Tabled 12/4/07, 12/18/07):

Deb explained that the intent of the mutual aid agreement regarding immunity was explained in a letter from West Bend City Attorney Mary Schanning. The letter can be part of the agreement. John Norman moved and Ed Doerr seconded approval of the Mutual Aid Agreement. Carried unanimously.

Bruce Muckerheide, Stormwater Management Facility Maintenance Agreement (Tabled previously):

Deb Hoffman explained that there is still an error. John Norman moved to table it until the first meeting in February. Ed Doerr seconded it. Carried unanimously.

Reports:

Treasurer Monica Diaz reported that property tax collection is going well. Residents have commented that the bank continues to be a good option, and a few have paid with credit card over the Internet.

Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Cindy Komro reported that Deb Hoffman had given some good feedback on the Employee Handbook. She will make revisions based on that feedback and get the revised handbook to everyone by the end of February.

Town Attorney Deb Hoffmann mentioned that she will get Cindy additional handbook items. Mr. Zellmer has filed an appeal to the denial of the conditional use permit, alleging that the decision was arbitrary and capricious

(basic appeal language). The judge must make a decision based on whether the Board made a reasonable decision. There are no injunctions or restraining orders that prevent the Town from citing Mr. Zellmer. Deerview Court – the attorney is interested in doing a deposition later in January. He did not make it clear who he wanted to depose. Deb will get more information. Deer Print (Newburg) – the Town has filed a motion to dismiss, stating that Newburg has no capacity to bring this suit.

Supervisor Ed Doerr mentioned that he had been contacted from a few residents regarding snow plowing issues.

Supervisor John Norman was also contacted by a few residents regarding snow plowing issues. He referred them to Jim Wollner.

Payment of Bills:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Ed Doerr to pay bills totaling \$81,559.42, tax refunds of \$13, 241.16 and payroll of \$17,656.83. Carried unanimously.
