

Minutes from the Public Hearing – Held before the Town of Trenton Plan Commission  
Date and Time: March 11, 2008 – 7:00 P.M.  
Place: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Plan Commission Vice Chairman John Herlinger, Plan Commissioners Scott Schweizer, Matt Muckerheide, Dennis Kay, Joan Baumgartner (arrived after start of hearing), Mike Bykowski (arrived after start of hearing), Building Inspector/Zoning Administrator Frank Mayer, Town Clerk Barbara Davies.

Prior to the Public Hearing, notice was properly published.

Vice Chairman Herlinger called the Public Hearing to order at 7:00 PM. Herlinger read the entire notice of Public Hearing called to consider the petition of Douglas Kohl, owner of Falls Archery, for a conditional use permit in accordance with Article III, Sections 380-27 M-1 Industrial District, (D) Conditional Uses Section 380-50 (O): “Indoor recreational facilities for activities and sports”. One of the permitted conditional uses under the ordinances is archery ranges.

Herlinger called on Falls Archery owner Doug Kohl. Kohl explained that he would like to move his archery range business from its current site in Menomonee Falls to a 1.1 acre parcel on Cal Drive in the Trenton Industrial Park. The building would have a parking lot large enough for 30 cars, and the pitch on the parking lot would drain the water to a drainage ditch. The business would be located next to the existing mini-storage business on Cal Drive. Jerry Thull will post a letter of credit for the required road construction. A question was asked about signage on the building. Kohl said that the existing sign in Menomonee Falls would be moved and placed on the building; the sign will be illuminated with lighting from above the sign. Scott Schweizer asked if archery leagues would meet at the building, and Kohl said they would. Schweizer asked if 30 parking spaces would be adequate, and Kohl said 30 spaces would be enough.

There were no other questions or comments.

Vice Chairman Herlinger closed the Public hearing at 7:10 PM.

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Minutes from the Public Hearing – Held before the Town of Trenton Plan Commission

Present: Same attendees as the Public Hearing at 7:00 PM

Vice Chairman Herlinger called the Public Hearing to order at 7:15 PM. Herlinger read the entire notice of Public Hearing called to consider the petition of Lee and Mary Kidney for a conditional use permit to be issued in accordance with Article 3, Section 380-33 (B)(3)(a) livestock allowed in CES-5 zoning. Kidneys seek a conditional use permit for the keeping of four to twelve angora goats for fleece.

Mary Kidney handed out a picture of several angora goats, stating that the fleece can be sold, processed, or made into socks. Joan Baumgartner asked what would be done with the animal waste. Lee Kidney said that the waste would be composted. The goats are small, about 24” tall at the shoulder and weighing about 50 pounds.

Baumgartner asked how the animals would be kept. Lee Kidney showed pictures of plans for a small barn. There will be a fenced enclosure; pasturage will be rotated. Scott Schweizer asked if Kidneys' property is wild or natural. Mary Kidney answered that approximately 1 acre of the property ( 937 STH 33 East) is in prairie restoration. John Norman asked how many goats would be covered by the application; Mary is applying for up to 12 goats. Norman asked how many acres Kidneys own. The property is 8 acres in size.

Baumgartner asked if the Kidneys had studied or researched the goats. Kidneys said they had traveled to several places to see goats, and to learn about what the goats need.

There were no further questions or comments.

Vice Chairman Herlinger closed the Public Hearing at 7:22 PM.
