

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: October 21, 2008 – 7:30 P.M.

Place: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Chairman Joe Gonnering, Supervisor Ed Doerr, Supervisor John Norman, Town Clerk Barbara Davies, Treasurer Monica Diaz, Deputy Clerk /Treasurer Cindy Komro, Building Inspector/Zoning Administrator Frank Mayer.

Prior to the Meeting, notice was properly posted on the Town Bulletin Boards and mailed to the West Bend Daily News and WBKV AM/FM.

Chairman Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:35 P.M.

Approval of Minutes – Town Board Meeting of October 7, 2008:

It was moved by Ed Doerr and seconded by Joe Gonnering to approve the Minutes of the October 7, 2008 Town Board Meeting. Carried unanimously.

Comments and Questions:

Accept/Review Agenda:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Ed Doerr to accept the Agenda as presented. Carried unanimously.

Approve Issuance of Operator's License – Kyle Mueller:

Mueller's record check is not yet complete. It was moved by Ed Doerr and seconded by John Norman to table action on approval to the Town Board Meeting of 11/3/08. Carried unanimously.

Status of Paving - Stark Asphalt:

Joe Gonnering reported that the paving work has been satisfactorily completed. It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Ed Doerr to pay Stark the balance due for the paving work. Carried unanimously.

Approve Attendance at WisDOT Winter Road Maintenance Seminar:

It was moved by Ed Doerr and seconded by John Norman to approve attendance by Jim Wollner and Lance Unger at WisDOT's Winter Road Maintenance Seminar in Pewaukee 10/21/08. Carried unanimously.

SEWRPAC Presentation to Plan Commission, Comprehensive Plan Chapters 4-7:

Frank Mayer reported that SEWRPAC representatives had presented draft chapters 4-7 of the Comprehensive Plan to the Plan Commission. Some of the maps have been reviewed. Mayer updated the Board on some sites on the maps identified by the DNR as "contaminated". The Town Board can review and reclass the sites if not considered contaminated. Discussion followed.

Preliminary Budget Discussion:

Clerk Barb Davies presented the preliminary 2009 budget. Discussion followed. The 2008 fuel surcharges on garbage and recycling collection will result in a higher fee for garbage and recycling in 2009. The Public Budget Hearing will be 11/11/08 prior to the Plan Commission Meeting.

Reports:

Frank Mayer reported a call from a resident stating that the Town's reflective plastic house number tiles are no longer available at Menards etc. Frank will check to see if the numbers are being discontinued. Falls Archery is moving forward with its building plans. Another business is looking at a lot on Cal Drive for storage facilities. One more new home permit application is coming in, which will bring the year-to-date total to nine homes.

Cindy Komro reported being very busy with work for the 11/4/08 election: voter registrations, HAVA checks, gaining lots of SVRS experience. Komro and Treasurer Monica Diaz will be setting the new computer up this week.

Monica Diaz reported receiving property tax calls already. Diaz will call J Mael for the tax collection program.

Barb Davies reported issuance of lots on absentee ballots for 11/4/08.

Chairman Joe Gonnering reported one call on absentee voting. The County is going through the budget process, trying to hold many departments to no more than a 3% increase over 2008.

Supervisor Ed Doerr asked a question about the citizen complaint about a business operating on Barber Circle. The Ozaukee/Washington Land Trust called re: a parcel near Lovers Lane.

Supervisor John Norman reported on the first meeting of the Park Committee, charged with establishing justification for the park fee. Norman presented a copy of the minutes to the Board. The Assembly Bill 241 has time deadlines for the plan, and deadlines for spending the money collected as a park fee. Norman said that the Committee is looking at land that may not be buildable but that would support trails, etc.

Payment of Bills:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Ed Doerr to pay bills totaling \$34,325.25 and payroll of \$9,925.11. Carried unanimously.
