

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: August 18, 2009 – 7:30 P.M.

Place: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Chairman Joe Gonnering, Supervisor Ed Doerr, Supervisor John Norman, Town Clerk Barbara Davies, Treasurer Monica Diaz, Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Cindy Komro, Building Inspector/Zoning Administrator Frank Mayer.

Affidavit of Posting:

Prior to the Meeting, notice was properly posted on the Town Bulletin Boards and mailed to the West Bend Daily News and WBKV AM/FM.

Pledge of Allegiance:

Chairman Gonnering invited all in attendance to join in saying the pledge of allegiance prior to the meeting.

Chairman Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:30 P.M.

Approval of Minutes – Town Board Meeting of August 4, 2009:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Ed Doerr to approve the Minutes of the Town Board Meeting of 8/4/09. Carried unanimously.

Affidavit of Posting:

Chairman Gonnering stated that the Agenda for tonight's meeting had been posted as required and an affidavit of posting has been filed.

Comments and Questions from the Audience:

Accept/Review Agenda:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Ed Doerr to accept the Agenda with this amendment: move agenda item #8, Newburg Fire Department Contract Proposal, to the first action item on the agenda. Carried unanimously.

Newburg Fire Department Contract Proposal:

Fire Chief Dave Geidel presented the contract proposed for the period January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2012. The proposed price for fire protection services is: 2010, \$168,559.94; 2011, \$176,988.94; 2012, \$185,838.38. It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Ed Doerr to approve the contract as proposed for January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2012. Carried unanimously.

Plan Commission Recommendation - Ray Repinski, Certified Survey Map:

Frank Mayer told the Board that the Plan Commission had approved Repinski's map at its July 2009 meeting. All required corrections have been made. It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Ed Doerr to approve Ray Repinski's Certified Survey Map. Carried unanimously.

Mike Devine-Plat of Survey:

Frank Mayer explained that because this is an interior land transfer, no signature page is needed because a quit claim deed will be filed. The only required correction to the map was the zoning, and that correction has been made. Devine will record the documents at the Register of Deeds office.

Approve Issuance of Operators License – Brianna Rahoy:

Brianna Rahoy has passed record check. It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Ed Doerr to approve issuance of an operator’s license to Rahoy. Carried unanimously.

Frank Mayer updated the Board on a recent attempt to obtain Newburg’s approval on a land division

Cindy Komro handed out a draft of the newsletter. Komro is still waiting for several articles that have been promised.

Barb Davies reported that small claims actions would be commenced against several people owing personal property tax, and also two property damage cases. The fall water testing date has been taken by another township, but a June 2010 date was available and accepted.

Joe Gonnering had nothing further to report.

Ed Doerr reported that he has tried a new poison ivy killer from Ortho, and it worked on the poison ivy within one week.

John Norman reported that he had received a call/complaint regarding deer shining.

Payment of Bills:

It was moved by Ed Doerr and seconded by John Norman to approve for payment bills in the amount of \$52,886.38 and payroll of \$9,366.87. Carried unanimously.

Other Business:

Joe Gonnering reported that he had attended a special meeting at the Town of Farmington Plan Commission. The speaker at that meeting was opposed to “Smart Growth”, and wanted to adopt “coordinated planning”. Towns over 2500 in population cannot do that, and must follow the “Smart Growth” process. If Trenton did adopt “coordinated planning”, the Town would give away all zoning authority.
