

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: March 17, 2009 – 7:30 P.M.

Place: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Chairman Joe Gonnering, Supervisor Ed Doerr, Town Clerk Barbara Davies, Treasurer Monica Diaz, Deputy Clerk /Treasurer Cindy Komro, Town Attorney Deb Hoffmann, Frank Mayer. Excused: Supervisor John Norman.

Pledge of Allegiance:

Chairman Gonnering invited all in attendance to join in saying the pledge of allegiance prior to the meeting.

Chairman Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:30 P.M.

Approval of Minutes – Town Board Meeting of March 3, 2009:

It was moved by Ed Doerr and seconded by Joe Gonnering to approve the Minutes of the March 3, 2009 Town Board Meeting. Carried unanimously.

Comments and Questions:

Mike Bykowski asked if Supervisor John Norman had any luck in determining AT&T's plans for offering "Uverse" in the Town. Brief discussion followed. There is no commitment at this time from AT&T for "Uverse" offerings.

Accept/Review Agenda:

It was moved by Ed Doerr and seconded by Joe Gonnering to accept the Agenda as presented. Carried unanimously.

Approve Participation in the WisDOT Salt Bid, 2009-2010 Winter Season:

It was moved by Ed Doerr and seconded by Joe Gonnering to approve participation in the upcoming WisDOT salt bid. Carried unanimously.

The road tour will take place Thursday, April 9, 2009 beginning at 7:30 PM. The Town Board will meet at the Town Hall at that time. The Clerk will post notice of the tour.

Notification of Plan Commission Action, Resolution Approving Town Comprehensive Plan:

Frank Mayer told the Board that the Plan Commission has approved the Resolution and has recommended it for approval to the Town Board. The Public Hearing on the Plan, to be held before the Town Board, has been set for April 21, 2009, 7:00 PM at the Town Hall.

Approval/Signing of Mediation Agreement, Deer View Court:

Attorney Deb Hoffmann told the Board that the road has been completed, and the mediation agreement has been signed by all other parties to the agreement. It was moved by Ed Doerr and seconded by Joe Gonnering to approve the mediation agreement. Carried unanimously. Doerr and Gonnering signed the agreement.

It was moved by Joe Gonnering and seconded by Ed Doerr to approve dates as follows:

Cindy Komro reported that she is setting up the shop computer. Komro would like a few more articles for the newsletter, which will go out around April 8.

Monica Diaz reported that she is working on personal property taxes. Three letters were sent out to businesses owing delinquent personal property tax.

Barb Davies reported that a good turnout is expected for the election.

Attorney Deb Hoffmann reported that briefs have been filed in the Deer Print case. Newburg will file a reply brief next week, then everything will go to the Court of Appeals. A tentative agreement has been reached via the Zellmer mediation. The tentative agreement will go first to the Plan Commission, then to the Town Board. Consideration of the Comprehensive Plan has been scheduled for the 4/21/09 Town Board Meeting.

Joe Gonnering reported that pothole patching work is going on.

Ed Doerr reported a complaint from Kevin Juech about equipment parked on the corner of Oak and MapleDale. Frank Mayer said that he had called the owner of the equipment and it will be moved. Spring weeds are coming up.

Payment of Bills:

It was moved by Ed Doerr and seconded by Joe Gonnering to approve for payment bills in the amount of \$41,817.08 and payroll of \$13,305.06. Carried unanimously.
