

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: Monday, April 5, 2010 – 3:00 P.M. (Date and time changed due to conflict with Spring Election)

Place: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Chairman Joe Gonnering, Supervisor Ed Doerr, Supervisor John Norman, Town Clerk Barbara Davies, Roads Supervisor Jim Wollner.

Chairman Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 3:05 P.M.

Gonnering stated that, as the Meeting is being held in the Conference Room (no American flag), we would not recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Ed Doerr to approve the Minutes of the Town Board Meetings of March 16, 2010 and March 30, 2010. Voting aye: 3. Nay: 0.

Affidavit of Posting:

Chairman Gonnering read the affidavit of posting, stating that prior to the Meeting, notice was properly posted on the Town Bulletin Boards and mailed to the West Bend Daily News and WBKV AM/FM.

Accept/Review Agenda:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Ed Doerr to approve the Agenda as presented. Voting aye: 3. Nay: 0.

Approve Issuance of Bartenders License – Nicholas Gudex (Waldens):

Gudex has passed Police Department record check. It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Ed Doerr to approve issuance of a license to Nicholas Gudex. Voting aye: 3. Nay: 0.

Possible Bid Award: Hot Mix Asphalt; Pulverize, Grade, Roll; Gravel; Shoulder Gravel:

Jim Wollner presented a list of roads considered “priorities”. If Pleasant Hill is chosen for paving, 3.5” of paving will be needed due to the poor base on that road. 2.5” of pavement would be acceptable for the other roads. Two bids were submitted: Payne & Dolan, and Stark Asphalt. Payne and Dolan’s bid is the lowest. It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Ed Doerr to award the bid to Payne & Dolan, with the roads chosen for paving to be identified within the next few weeks. Voting aye: 3. Nay: 0.

Possible Bid Award – Crackfilling:

Wollner told the Board that he had contacted Scott Construction to clear up several issues with the company’s bid. Scott’s has confirmed that the bid does include a possible additional charge for a fuel surcharge; the company also does not crackfill to the sides of the roads. Discussion followed. It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Ed Doerr to award the crackfilling bid to N&R Asphalt Maintenance. Voting aye: 3. Nay: 0.

Approve Resolution 5-1-2010, Designating 5/9/2010-5/15/2010 as National Police Week in the Town of Trenton:

It was moved by Ed Doerr and seconded by John Norman to approve Resolution 5-1-2010, designating 5/9/2010-5/15/2010 as National Police Week in the Town of Trenton. Voting aye: 3. Nay: 0.
