Joe Gonnering reported that there are a lot of potholes in the Town. The Wallace Lake Road manhole was fixed but it still pops open when a car hits it. He left a message for the Sanitary District, but mentioned that we may need to take care of it and bill the Sanitary District for the work.

Ed Doerr had nothing to report.

John Norman reported that he received a telephone call that a deer that was shot with an arrow was dropped on his property. John called the DNR.

Captain Grissom had nothing to report.

Payment of Bills:
