

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: Monday, June 7, 2011, 7:30 PM

Place: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Chairman Joe Gonnering, Supervisor Ed Doerr, Supervisor John Norman, Town Clerk Cindy Komro, Treasurer Monica Diaz, Department of Public Works Director James Wollner.

Chairman Gonnering asked those in attendance to join in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:36 P.M.

Approval of Minutes of Town Board Meeting of May 17, 2011:

It was moved by John Norman and seconded by Ed Doerr to approve the Minutes of the Town Board Meeting of May 17, 2011. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

Affidavit of Posting:

Chairman Gonnering read the affidavit of posting, stating that prior to the Meeting, notice was properly posted on the Town Bulletin Boards and mailed to the West Bend Daily News and WBKV AM/FM.

Comments and Questions from the Audience:

Accept/Review Agenda:

It was moved by Ed Doerr and seconded by John Norman to approve the Agenda as presented. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

Dissolution of Sand Drive Sanitary District:

The public hearing is set for June 21, 2011 at 7:00 PM before Town Board meeting. Resolution will be drafted by Town Attorney for approval at June 21 meeting.

Approval of Bartender License: Ashley Peterson, Stocky's Bar & Grill:

This bartender license will be considered at the June 21 meeting for licenses beginning July 1.

Resolution 2011.06.01, Dividing Town of Trenton into Municipal Wards:

The County approved a tentative County Supervisory Plan. Cindy Komro met with Planning & Parks to design a Ward Plan. The new plan reduces the number of wards from seven to six and cleans up the lines. Ed Doerr moved to table action on this Resolution to the June 21 meeting. John Norman seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

Approve Membership – Wisconsin Towns Association, 7/1/11-6/30/12 (Budgeted Membership):

Cindy Komro spoke about a new service offered for online training, for an additional annual fee of \$100. Monica Diaz said that it might be worthwhile to have more training opportunities available, and the cost is reasonable. Joe Gonnering thought it might make sense to wait and see how valuable other municipalities believe it is. Ed Doerr thought we could add this at any time. Ed Doerr moved to approve the basic membership fee. John Norman seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

Possible Bid Award, Crackfilling and Cracksealing:

DPW Director Jim Wollner discussed the details of the bids. John Norman moved to award the Crackfilling and Cracksealing bid to Bartelt for \$12,804.18. Ed Doerr seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

Possible Bid Award, Hot Mix Asphalt; Pulverize, Grade & Roll; Gravel; Shoulder Gravel:

DPW Director Jim Wollner discussed the details of the bids. Wollner suggested that, due to budgetary constraints, the most needed work should be done, on Newark Dr, School Rd and Trenton Rd, the total cost of which comes within budget. He suggested that the necessary work on Trading Post Trl, Wallace Lake Dr and N Church Rd could be deferred to 2012. Ed Doerr moved to award the Hot Mix Asphalt; Pulverize, Grade & Roll; Gravel; Shoulder Gravel bid to Payne & Dolan for work on Newark Dr, School Rd and Trenton Rd for \$171,485.75. John Norman seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

Annexation Petitions:

None.

Reports:

Public Works Director Jim Wollner reported that he has tried to find a service for spraying the dandelions. West Bend Lakes has offered the service at a reasonable charge. This will be done in the fall. Wollner further reported that the steam cleaner lost pressure and was unable to properly clean the trucks. Response to a service call confirmed that there was significant calcium buildup on the coil in the steam cleaner. Wollner signed up for a routine maintenance service program at \$125 per year. Chairman Gonnering acknowledged that this is a low-cost insurance to protect the equipment.

Treasurer Monica Diaz reported receipt of the recycling grant in the amount of \$15,674.65. Diaz received a letter from a concerned citizen regarding a neighbor with four dogs on Barber Circle. Diaz has confirmed that none of the dogs are licensed. The complaint will be forwarded to the Police Department.

Clerk Cindy Komro reported that Daniel McCulloch will be doing work on the sports field this year. He also plans to advertise for the Athletics Program in the schools.

Chairman Joe Gonnering reported that the Carter home on Sandy Acres, which was refused a kennel license, had until June 1 to have three or fewer dogs. The owner called to say that the last dog would be picked up on Thursday, June 2. Gonnering believes they are now in compliance, and has had no calls to the contrary. Gonnering also reported that he will be attending a County Highway conference.

Supervisor Ed Doerr reported that he continues to find more poison ivy in the Town.

Supervisor John Norman reported that the FEMA representative is very good and that the Town should be receiving \$20,400. He also mentioned that the Farmland Preservation will continue to be discussed with the farmers. Some are very much in favor of it.

Payment of Bills:

John Norman moved to approve payment of bills totaling \$16,891.69 and (3-week) payroll totaling \$15,855.71. Ed Doerr seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.
