

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: Tuesday, November 1, 2011, 7:30 PM

Chairman Gonnering asked those in attendance to join in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance. Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:30 P.M.

Approval of Minutes of Town Board Meeting of October 18, 2011:

John Norman moved to approve the Minutes of the Town Board Meeting of October 18, 2011. Ed Doerr seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

Ed Doerr moved to accept the agenda as presented. John Norman seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

Concealed Carry at Town Hall

Chairman Gonnering explained that Wisconsin has legalized Concealed Carry as of November 1. Discussion followed regarding the rules for Municipal buildings and Police Departments, and the position the County has taken. John Norman moved to have Attorney Schoonenberg draft an ordinance regarding concealed carry with respect to the Town Hall building in accordance with state regulations. Ed Doerr seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

Mid-Moraine Municipal Court Representative

Chairman Gonnering moved to appoint Ed Doerr as Mid-Moraine Municipal Court Representative. John Norman seconded. Voting in favor: 2. Opposed: 0. Abstained: 1.

Approve Resolution 2011.11.01, Regarding the Imposition of Dog License Fees

John Norman moved to approve Resolution 2011.11.01, Regarding the Imposition of Dog License Fees. Ed Doerr seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

Approve Payment to Town Treasurer Per Processed Dog License

Treasurer Monica Diaz explained that her per processed dog license fee is currently \$1.50 total (\$0.75 from the County; \$0.75 from the Town). Ed Doerr moved to increase the Town payment to the Treasurer for each processed dog license to \$1.25. John Norman seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

Approve Jamestown Architecture

Ed Doerr moved to approve the Jamestown Architecture. John Norman seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

Athletics Program Fees

The Athletics program fees were discussed with respect to the costs, including the salary for the Athletics Director. No action was taken.

Department of Public Works Director Jim Wollner reported that the Congress Drive trees have been cut, and the residents are pleased with the results. The Wingate wall is completed. Town Treasurer Monica Diaz had nothing to report.

Town Attorney Tim Schoonenberg had nothing to report.

Town Chairman Joseph Gonnering reported that the Town will not be receiving TRIP funds next year. Gonnering met with Steve Awve regarding his property and the State wetland delineation requirements.

Town Supervisor Ed Doerr reported on the debris issue on the Wallace Lake property, and requested that Attorney Schoonenberg follow up.

Town Supervisor John Norman reported on the Emergency Government radio.
