

What is a Small Business – VSQG Clean Sweep?

It is an opportunity for Very Small Quantity Generators (VSQGs) such as small businesses to dispose of unwanted, unused, damaged, and/or banned hazardous chemicals (especially pesticides).

Small Business (VSQG) Participation

The definition of a Very Small Quantity Generator (VSQG) is a business that generates less than 220 lbs./month and stores less than 2,205 lbs. of hazardous waste. Small businesses that meet pesticide licensing categories regulated by DATCP are encouraged to participate.

What Is The Cost?

Businesses will work one-on-one with Veolia Environmental Service to determine final costs of disposal.

Unaccepted Waste:

1. Latex Paint
2. Radioactives (including smoke alarms)
3. Infectious and biological wastes
4. Freon 11 and 12
5. Vehicle Batteries
6. Explosives (including detonators and blasting caps)

We will accept most unknown chemicals which are often of unidentified origin.
